CERPs include

- CRP/AED trained onsite team
- Written response plan
- Properly installed and maintained AED(s)
- Cardiac emergency response drills
- Communication with EMS and school community

The program has protected 39,000 hearts plus 1000s more given an estimated 20% of the population is on a school campus each day.

For 55% of schools, this was their first AED

of schools did not have a dedicated cardiac emergency response plan prior to participating in Get Charged Up

Nearly 30%

of participants reported an SCA had happened at their school
