

SHAPE America-APEAS II License Agreement

This Agreement outlines your rights and responsibilities as a Licensee and Authorized User of the SHAPE America-APEAS II Software. Please read it carefully and note, in particular, that your license is not valid unless you agree to the terms of this License Agreement.

Definitions

The following definitions apply to the terms as they appear in this Agreement.

Licenser

Refers to the owner of the proprietary web Web Application known as Society of Health and Physical Educators (SHAPE America), a national association located in Reston, VA.

Licensee

Usually refers to a school district, institution, or organization which is clearly identifiable by name and which is under the direction of one superintendent, administrator, manager or controller who determines the names of the Authorized Users. When the license is purchased by an individual, the individual is considered the Licensee and the Authorized User.

Authorized User

Means any individual authorized by the Licensee to use this program whose name appears in the drop-down menu "Authorized User" on this Web Application.

Web Application

Means any part of the program contained in the SHAPE America-APEAS II Online Web Application, including but not limited to the documentation, data set and electronic score sheets. The term also includes copies of and updates to any part of the program.

Documentation

Means manuals and other support materials accompanying the Web Application, whether in printed or electronic form.

Copyright/ownership

The Web Application is a proprietary product protected by United States and copyright laws. The Licenser retains the title to and ownership of the Web Application, which is licensed, not sold, to the Licensee.

License

Licenser grants all Authorized Users of the Licensee non-exclusive license to use the Web Application. The license is effective upon receipt of agreed compensation.

An Authorized User may:

Use the Web Application to produce an unlimited number of printed documents, such as reports, score sheets, and performance profiles.

Produce PDF files containing documents created by this Web Application for achieve purposes.

Further, an Authorized User may:

Copy any documents produced by the Web Application

Copy any Documentation which is printed and unbound, including this Agreement, quick reference charts, and installation notes.

Print any Documentation which is distributed in electronic form, provided the printouts are for the Authorized User's own personal use.

An Authorized User may *not*:

Reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the Web Application.

Remove in any manner the name of Licensee, name of the Authorized User, or copyright information from any document created by this Web Application.

Print or copy all or part of a document created with this software that does not contain the name of Licensee, name of Authorized User and copyright information.

Place Documentation on a network, Web site, electronic bulletin board, or any place that a person who is not licensed or authorized to use the Software may gain access to it.

Distribute the Documentation to any person who is not an Authorized User associated with the Licensee.

Distribute documents that contain copyrighted material, including documents created by this software program which is not related to the Authorized User's official duties of the Licensee.

Use the Web Application for any commercial activity, including typesetting of books and manuscripts, software development, and private tutoring, or for any other activity which is not related to the Authorized User's official duties of the Licensee.

Miscellaneous

Support is provided to a single technical contact of the Licensee and not necessarily to each individual Authorized User. Support by the Authorized User should be referred to the Licensee's single technical contact before contacting Support.

This License is not transferable and Authorized Users must be associated with the Licensee. In the event that an Authorized User is no longer associated with the Licensee, the former Authorized User surrenders the right to use the Web Application.

The Authorized User's use of the Web Application is an acknowledgement that the Authorized User has read this Agreement, understands it, and agrees to be bound by its terms and conditions. Furthermore, the Licensee acknowledges a responsibility to share this Agreement with all other Authorized Users who have been given access to or are given copies of the Web Application or Documentation.

Licenser may terminate this Agreement at any time if an Authorized User or other person associated with the Licensee is in breach of any of the terms or conditions of this Agreement. Upon termination, Licensee and all Authorized Users will immediately destroy all copies of the Software at the work site, at their homes or laptop computers.

Limited Warranty

Licenser warrants the Web Application and Documentation to be free of defects in materials and workmanship at time of receipt. This warranty does not cover defects that result from

accident, abuse, or misuse of the Web Application. In all cases, Licensor's total liability and the exclusive remedy of the Licensee is limited to the purchase price of the License.

EXCEPT FOR THE LIMITED WARRANTY ABOVE, ALL DOCUMENTATION ARE PROVIDED "AS IS." NO WARRANTY IS EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED AS TO THE PERFORMANCE OF THE SOFTWARE OR ITS SUITABILITY FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. LICENSER SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY LOSS OF PROFITS, LOSS OF USE, INTERRUPTION OF ACTIVITY, OR INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND WHETHER UNDER THIS AGREEMENT OR OTHERWISE.
